Dear Parents, Carers and Parishioners,



You can now access free online help from a leading children's mental health and wellbeing organisation - Thrive. Thrive® is an emotional and social development programme that has been used in our setting for several years and have launched the Thrive-Online Parent Toolkit as part of its response to the coronavirus pandemic, enabling parents and carers of children aged 4 to 11 to access practical guidance and information. Thrive is well known for the training and online services it provides to teachers and other education professionals to support children's social and emotional development. The new toolkit draws on this expertise to provide a resource for parents and carers who may be home schooling or helping children to manage uncertainty relating to the coronavirus situation. The online toolkit provides information explaining the different, age-related stages of a child's social and emotional development so that parents can better understand what their children's behaviour is telling them about their needs. The idea is to introduce parents and carers to the developmental model used by Thrive and to provide them with age-appropriate strategies and activities to try with their children at home. It also highlights the importance of parents and carers looking after their own well-being so that they have the mental and emotional resources needed to support their children.
