- Encourage the players to respect the opposition, referee and match officials.
- Support positively. When players make a mistake offer them encouragement not criticism.
- Never engage in offensive, insulting, or abusive language or behaviour.

Failure to follow this code of conduct could result in you being asked to leave a Schools Competition/Fixture. The matter can be referred to the Principal of the School or PE & Wellbeing Coordinator.
